Title of the workshop session

*Assessing impacts of professional (labour) inclusion
of vulnerable people in agriculture*

The importance of labour inclusion in European agriculture is very unequal. We would like to reflect and discuss the effectiveness of such projects. To tackle this dimension, we need to define the criteria for measuring effectiveness: what do we want to assess and how?

- and the way impact assessment is carried out.
